Instructions for Applicants

Applicants for admission to the Master of Law (LL.M.) program must have completed the first degree in law required for law practice or law teaching in the country in which law studies were pursued. U.S. applicants must have an ABA-accredited J.D. degree. In exceptional cases, U.S. applicants with non-ABA-accredited law degrees may be considered. Applicants for admission to the Entertainment, Media and Sports Law Certificate must have received a bachelor's degree from an approved college or university prior to registration. The following steps must be completed prior to consideration for admission:

1. Filing of Application

Complete the Application for Admission. Please make sure that all questions have been answered completely, since failure to do so will delay consideration by the Admissions Committee. Questions that cannot be answered in the space provided may be continued on a separate page. Applications for the LL.M. program can also be completed online through www.lsac.org.

Your application must be accompanied by a \$50 nonrefundable application fee in the form of a check or money order made payable to Pepperdine University. Please ensure that your name and social security number are on your check.

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis and should be submitted at least four months prior to the intended start date with courses starting in mid-August, January and late May. It is recommended that international students submit applications at least 6 months prior to their expected start date, and applications can be submitted up to one year in advance.

2. Testing Requirements

All international applicants are required to demonstrate English proficiency by taking the TOEFL or IELTS exam. Information on the exams can be found on the following websites:

The TOEFL and IELTS exam are given via scheduled appointment at your local testing center. Students attending an English program at a UC school can visit straus.pepperdine.edu for a special waiver program.

3. Letters of Recommendation

Three Prospective Student Evaluation Forms or narrative letters of recommendation are required. Applicants for the Entertainment, Media and Sports Law programs are strongly encouraged to submit one of the three recommendations from an individual associated with the field. No decision regarding admission will be made until these forms have been received by the School of Law.

4. Transcripts

Official copies of transcripts from all colleges or universities attended is required. Applicants who possess a J.D. degree must also provide their class rank.
